- HGVs make up 4% of London traffic

 - 58% of cyclist fatalities
 - 22.5% of pedestrian fatalities

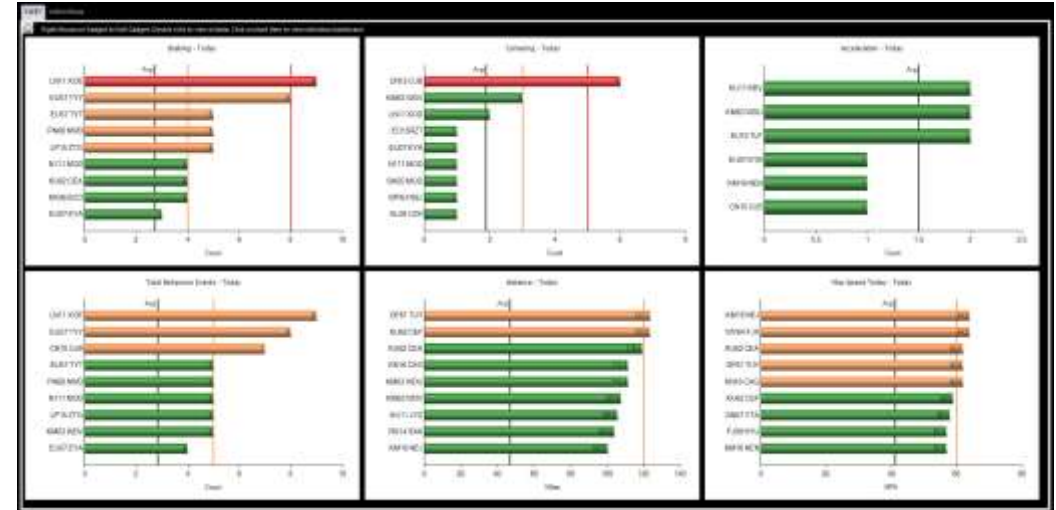

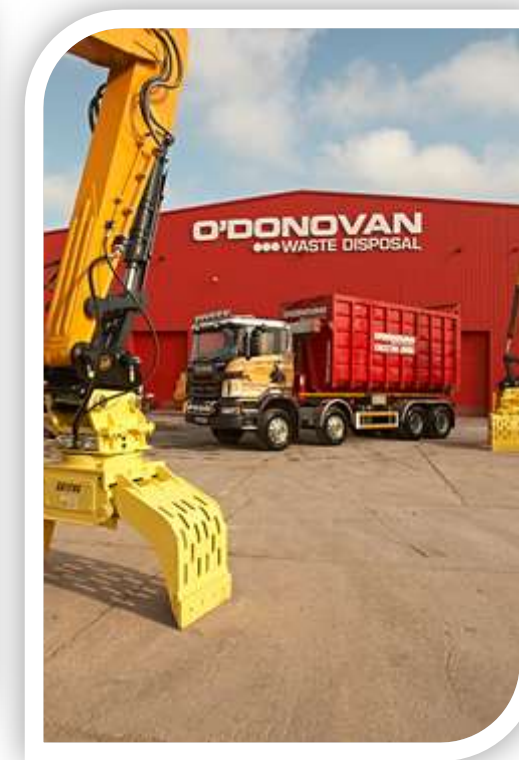
